1) Normal PLTW® high school situation

2) If a high school teacher is teaching PLTW® courses to high school students on a college campus, then the PLTW® program belongs to the high school and the high school district must sign a *School District Agreement*. The college is merely acting as a "neutral site" for course instruction and does not need an agreement.

3) If a college professor is teaching PLTW® courses to high school students at the high school, then the PLTW® program belongs to the high school and the high school district must sign a *School District Agreement*. The college professor would register under the high school and follow the same procedures as any high school teacher.

4) If a college professor is teaching PLTW® courses to high school students on a college campus, then the PLTW® program belongs to the college the college must sign a *Post-Secondary Agreement: Secondary Student Learning*. (Note: If the high school students are also taking PLTW® courses at their high school, a *School District Agreement* is needed for the high school district as well.)

5) If a college professor is teaching PLTW® courses to college students at the college, then the PLTW® program belongs to the college and the college must sign a *Post-Secondary Agreement: Post-Secondary Student Learning*.

6) If a college professor is teaching PLTW® courses to BOTH high school students AND college students at the college, then the PLTW® program belongs to the college and the college must sign BOTH a *Post-Secondary Agreement: Secondary Student Learning* AND a *Post-Secondary Agreement: Post-Secondary Student Learning*. (Note: If the high school students are also taking PLTW® courses at their high school, a *School District Agreement* is needed for the high school district as well.)

7) If college students are taking PLTW® courses at a Pre-Service University (meaning they will be certified to teach PLTW® courses to secondary students at course completion), the Pre-Service University will sign a *Pre-Service Agreement*, and will be registered as a "university" in the PLTW® database. Neither versions of the *Post-Secondary Agreement* apply to Pre-Service Universities.

**** Software is purchased through the institution that has signed the agreement, regardless of who is paying for it. All institutions (school districts and post-secondary institutions) will be required to sign a Software Lease Agreement.**
