

PLTW Grants Application Guide

Your quick guide for successfully applying for grant funding that supports your PLTW program.

When to Apply

- Grant cycle runs July 1 – June 30
- Apply early in the school year to maximize opportunities

**After you apply, PLTW will continue to consider your application for other grants throughout the 2025–26 cycle, which ends June 30.*

Eligibility

PLTW grants are open to:

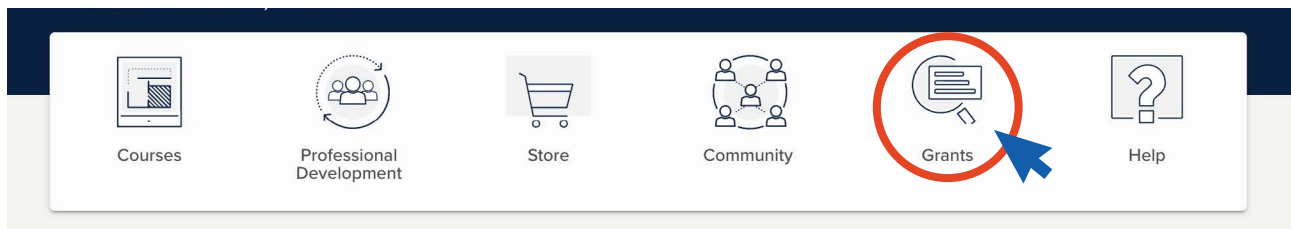
- Traditional public schools
- Public charter schools
- Nonprofit private schools

(All must be located in the U.S. or its territories)

Each grant has unique partner criteria (location, program type, grade level). With one application per program, PLTW will match you to all opportunities your school qualifies for.


How to Apply

- Log in or create a [myPLTW](#) account
- Select the **Grants icon** and click **Start an Application**
- Complete all fields and click **Save & Submit**



Tips

- You can save and return later
- Applications cannot be edited after submission
- Only one application per program, per cycle

What We Look For

- **Readiness:** Clear, feasible plan
- **Access:** Broad student reach
- **Impact:** Measurable outcomes
- **Sustainability:** Program continues beyond grant period

Tips for Success

- Be clear and specific (avoid acronyms)
- Use complete sentences
- Have a colleague review before submitting

Grant Contacts

You'll need two contacts:

- Primary Contact – receives the grant agreement
- Secondary Contact – helps with reports and program tasks
